- Waiver of two courses may require the student taking six (6) credit hours of elective courses to ensure the student meets the 120 credit hours requirement for Ursuline graduation.
- Ursuline core requires student take courses that meet a culture designation of American (AM), Western (WE), and World (WO). With earned degree, student may not need to meet all three.
