Taking certain elective courses will allow the student to come in at junior status.

Block credit will be awarded to students by YSU for LPN and RN licensure (10-49 credits). This program awards maximum credit for an associate degree from Cuyahoga Community College, streamlining completion of a bachelor's degree from ***Youngstown State University***.

All students must meet or complete:

- all residency requirements 30 credits and 16 upper division for YSU, plus major and minor residency
- required clinicals
